## **Perryfields Primary School OVERVIEW of Pupil Premium Outcomes 2017-2018**

### **EYFS:**

The disadvantaged pupil cohort in EYFS was 2 out of 60 pupils. Both pupils made good progress in their learning throughout the year but, due to their identified Special Educational Needs, they did not achieve the EYFS pass mark.

### **Key Stage 1:**

Data shows that, while there was a gap between Perryfields disadvantaged pupils and the national non-disadvantaged pupils, Perryfields disadvantaged pupils made greater progress than national disadvantaged pupils in phonics, reading and writing.

### **Key Stage 2:**

Data shows that, while there was a gap between Perryfields disadvantaged pupils and the national non-disadvantaged pupils, Perryfields disadvantaged pupils made greater progress than national disadvantaged pupils in reading and maths, with a greater combined pass rate than national disadvantaged.
