- 1. Ensure that our child attends school regularly. We will always telephone if our child is absent and provide a note of explanation following absence.
- 2. Make sure that our child arrives at school on time, properly equipped for all lessons/P.E. activities.
- 3. Encourage our child to 'be the best they can be' and take an active interest in all aspects of our child's school life.
- 4. Ensure that our child completes their weekly homework/Learning Log activities.
- 5. Support our child's progress in reading by enabling them to regularly practise their skills at home and make comments in their reading record book.
- 6. Encourage our child to follow the school's behaviour policy and support any agreed action taken by the school via the Class Charts 'App'.
- 7. Ensure that our child wears the correct uniform to school; in line with the Uniform Policy (refer to the School Prospectus for details).
- 8. Attend Open Evenings to discuss our child's welfare and progress.
- 9. Inform the school directly about any concerns and problems that might affect our child's work or behaviour.
- 10. Read, agree to and sign the 'Parental Use of Social Networking' Policy.
- 11. Refrain from taking photos of pupils, including our own, on the school premises.
- 12. Adhere to COVID-19 related guidelines issued by the school to protect the school community.

- 3. Wear the correct uniform.
- 4. Be helpful and kind, always following the school rules.
