

WALT: plan and write a quest story.

Freedom for Bron is an adventure story. It is a **quest** story where the characters are on a **journey** to **solve a problem**.

Your quest story will have the following features

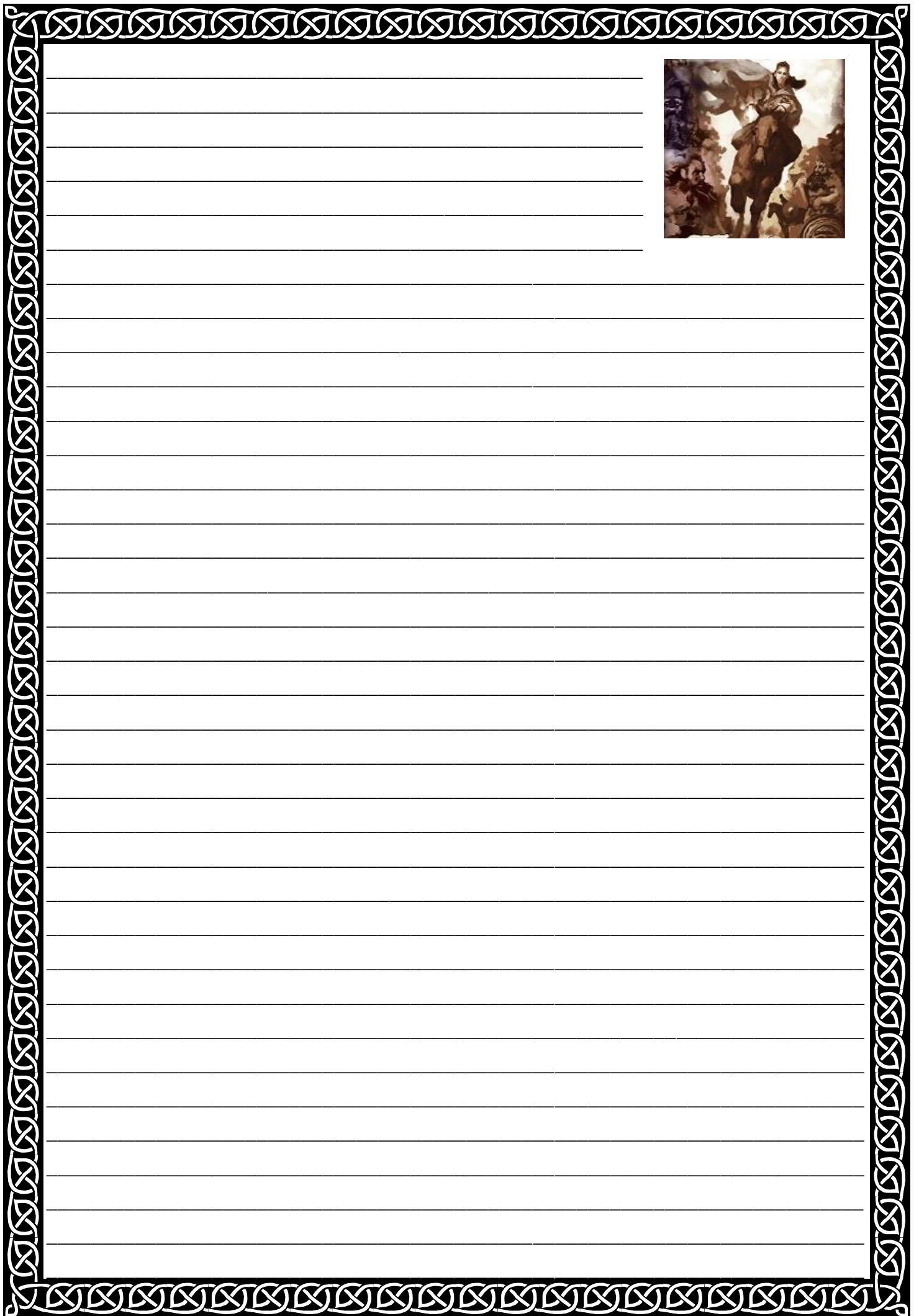
	Freedom for Bron	
Who and where	Beogard and the warriors in Anglo Saxon times Set in the summer time	Bron, a slave boy, working for a blacksmith has aspirations to be a warrior
The problem/quest	Saxons and Jutes are in conflict. Beogard to ask the Jute king, Eormenric, for peace	
The journey	Beogard and companions travel to Cantwareburh, coming across Jute village	
Meet other characters	Beogard gives Bron an amulet. Bron gains freedom and goes to join the Saxons on their journey	
Enemies/Obstacles	Saxons are attacked by Jutes. Beogard is left injured, the Saxon warriors are captured.	Bron follows Jutes and finds help from Cloda and Cleava.
How is the problem solved and the quest is completed?	Bron helps Beogard recover and arrives at Cantwareburh and agree peace.	

Think of an idea for your story :

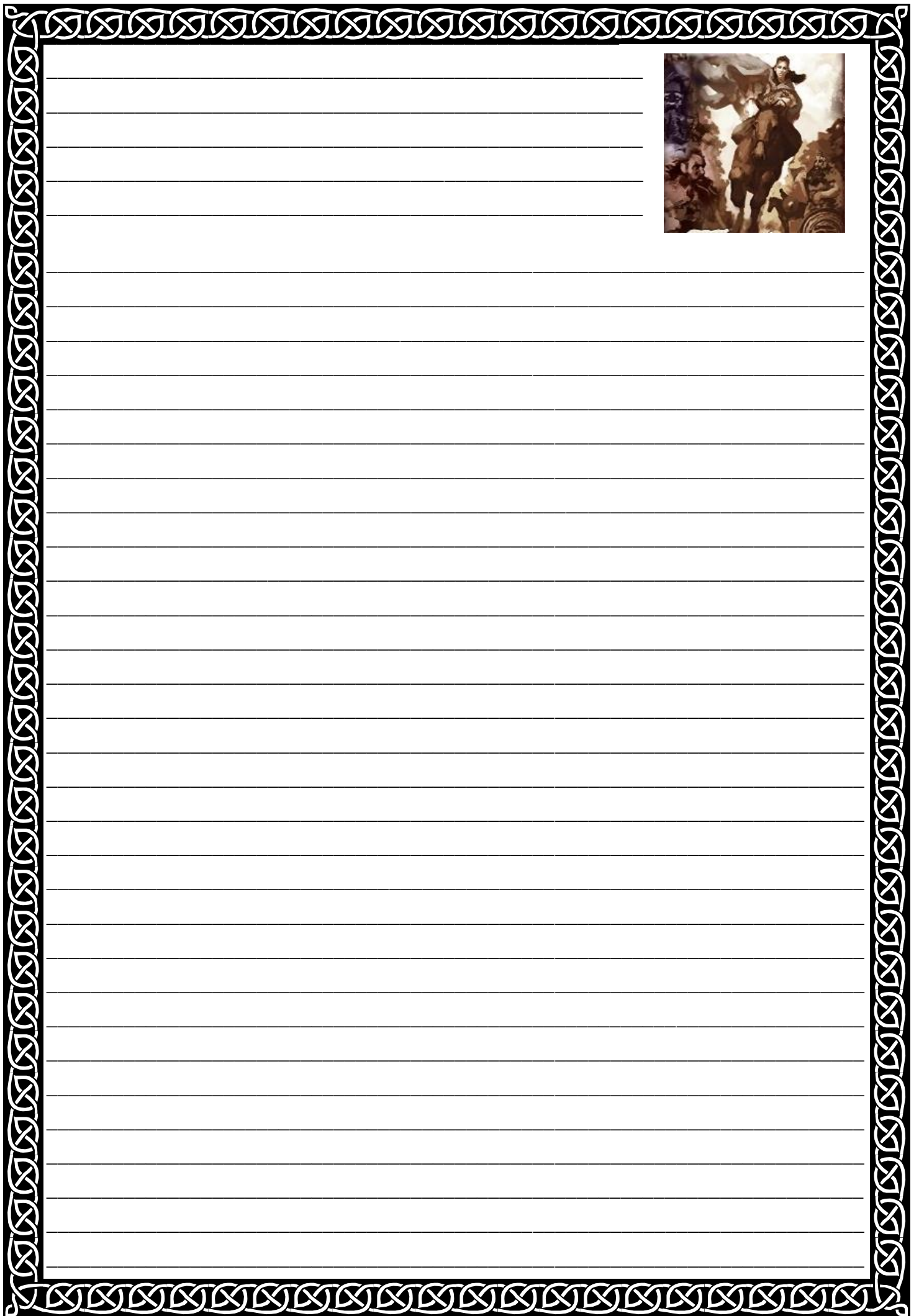
- Perhaps you are a warrior telling your tale at a Saxon feast. Describe an exciting journey that you have just made, tell what you found and what dangers you escaped from.
- Imagine you are an Anglo Saxon child who finds a precious sword left beside a tree. Describe the sword, tell how you found it. Who does it belong to? What happens next?
- Or think of a story of your own

1. Draw a story map of your story. Then tell your story to an adult
2. Write your story ideas in the story mountain template. Add exciting phrases.
3. Write your story – one paragraph for each box on your story mountain
4. Edit and improve your story, checking for fronted adverbials, exciting vocabulary and neat handwriting.
