Our Vision for Learning

Our school community works together to ensure that pupils receive a rich, inspiring and engaging education. Every child is taught the knowledge and skills to become independent lifelong learners, aspiring to all standards of high achievement in all aspects of their life.

At Perryfields Primary School we believe that healthy well rounded children have the best chance of achieving success at school and in the wider community. Children need to feel happy, safe and valued and that they are treated fairly. The school's commitment to this runs through all strands of school life.

In the curriculum there is an emphasis on PSHE – Personal, Social, Health Education – including circle times in class where children can talk about social issues at school. Class charts (well-being tab) allows school and parents to communicate and monitor the children's emotional well-being. Pupil voice is an important aspect of life at Perryfields. We have an active School Council where children learn to discuss issues and talk about ways to improve their school.

The use of Restorative Practice by all staff ensures that children feel listened to and that they have a chance to give their side of things even when they are in the wrong. Children are encouraged to take responsibility and to be part of the fixing process in matters of their behaviour. When things are not going well we think it's important that children are able to talk about it. Playground Buddies (Buddy Zone) are roles that the children take very seriously and give the children valuable life skills.

Throughout school life we are always looking for opportunities to check that children are feeling positive and enjoying school, class charts allows us to give parents instant feedback. We offer a wide range of extra curricular activities to give all children a chance to shine. Our Inclusion Manager and our Pastoral Team are always on hand to work with groups or individuals who may need a bit of extra support at school.
