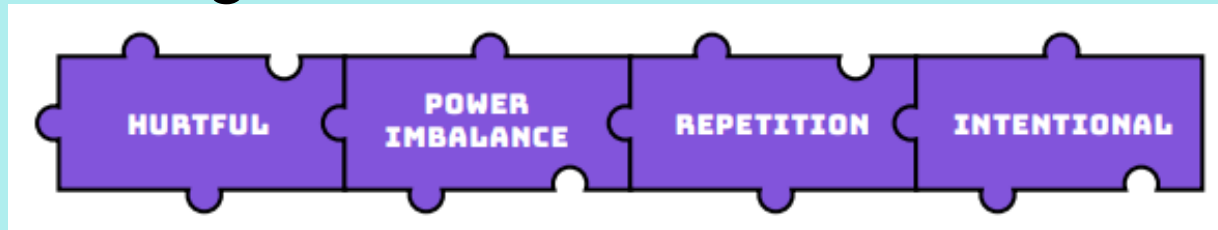


Wednesday 18th November



Think about the roles we looked at on Monday:

The ringleader(s) - Initiating and leading the bullying but not always the person 'doing' the bullying.

The target(s) - The person at whom the bullying is aimed.

Assistant(s) - Actively involved in 'doing' the bullying.

Reinforcer(s) - Supports the bullying, might laugh or encourage other people to 'collude' with what is going on.

Defender(s) - Stands up for someone being bullied. Knows that bullying is wrong and feels confident enough to do something about it. This might involve talking to an adult in school.

Outsider(s) - Ignores any bullying and doesn't want to get involved.

Write a short passage or create a poster of films you have watched or books you have read where these roles apply.

You must explain the scenario and the roles each character played. E.g.

Harry Potter

Scenario: Bullying at Hogwarts School of witchcraft and wizardry. Constant name calling and unkind comments. Spells are sometimes used against the targets.

Targets: Harry, Ron and Hermione.

Ring Leader: Draco Malfoy

Reinforcers: Crab and Goyle

Defender: Neville Longbottom

Another example you might consider is Matilda. Think about the roles of Matilda, Mrs Trunchball, Bruce Bogtrotter, Lavender.
