diurnal - active during the day and sleep at night.

crepuscular - relating to twilight. Done at night.

conserve - preserve something.

descendant - a person, plant, or animal that is descended from a particular ancestor.

colonies - a community of animals or plants of one kind living close together or forming a physically connected structure.

metabolic - relating to or deriving from the metabolism of a living organism.

Metabolism - the chemical processes that occur within a living organism in order to maintain life.

solitary - living alone.

congregate - gather into a crowd or group.

nocturnal - active during the night time.

arboreal - living in trees.

defecate - get rid of faeces from the body.

quadruped - an animal with four feet.
