Steps to Success

Decide headings for non-chronological report.

Use a range of sources to gather information (links provided).

Read through information about your chosen animal.

Use a dictionary to find the meaning of any unfamiliar vocabulary (technical vocabulary).

Write brief but effective notes under the correct headings.

Do not copy full sentences.

Use key words and phrases.

Do not copy chunks of text from the sources.

Task:

Today and tomorrow, you will be conducting your own, independent research about your chosen rainforest animal (not a household pet)! I have provided you with some links to use if you wish to or you could find your own and use any books that you may have too.

You are not to copy chunks of information! Your notes must be brief and effective.

You are to take notes as you go. Sort your notes underneath different subheadings so that when you come to write your reports, you have all of the information already organised.
